We were so impressed by the enthusiasm of each of the young writers to take on both the writing and parkour challenges! They not only proved they were capable of completing a story in a short space of time, but they now have a structure they can use again and again.

We were also blown away by the talented teen writers we met at Hamilton Library. They are excellent examples of what you can do with a single prompt, mixed with imagination and storytelling flair.

Because of that, the snail broke the limb of the tree. Because of that, he fell towards the lava and nearly died!


Luckily, he rolled and as he did so, he made a bridge and survived.

Apple Tree


Tamika

Because of that they had to go to the vet and get checked up. But when they went to the vet they found out their legs weren't broken so they went back home.


Finally, they vaulted back into their house and ate food. They chewed bones outside.


The next day the sheep was so angry about his broken leg that he didn't see the farmer about to turn him into lamb chops.

Once upon a time there was a horse that loved to get ridden. It always landed when it went over a jump. Every day she got ridden and went over jumps, and landed them safely.



Once upon a time there was a fox and it jumped over bright sewer and brand new fences. It was an orange fox. He lived in a den where it was really, really dirty.


Every day, the fox woke up and jumped over fifteen big logs,then went in a farmer's paddock and ate the sheep and lambs.

Ellie the Elephant



"Oh noooooo what happened?" cried the FBI agents, looking at the man. "He's dead! We will find you, table!"







He had to jump. "Oh no," he thought. He landed in a hole and couldn't get out.





Forever Blu


